AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 4-246, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO LIQUOR
PROHIBITIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 4-246, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 4-246. Violation; classification; screening, education or
5 treatment program

6 A. A person violating any provision of this title is guilty of a class
7 2 misdemeanor unless another classification is prescribed.

8 B. A person violating section 4-244, paragraph 9, 14, 33, 41 or 43 is
9 guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor.

10 C. In addition to any other penalty prescribed by law, a person who is
11 convicted of a violation of section 4-244, paragraph 41 shall pay a fine of
12 not less than five hundred dollars.

13 D. In addition to any other penalty prescribed by law, a person who is
14 convicted of a violation of section 4-241, ~~paragraph~~ SUBSECTION C, D or E
15 shall pay a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars.

16 E. IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PRESCRIBED BY LAW, A PERSON WHO IS
17 UNDER THE LEGAL DRINKING AGE AND WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SECTION
18 4-244, PARAGRAPH 9 SHALL COMPLETE A COURT ORDERED ALCOHOL OR OTHER DRUG
19 SCREENING, EDUCATION OR TREATMENT PROGRAM.
