## **SENATE BILL 1597**

## AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2351 AND 28-2403, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; REPEALING SECTIONS 28-2404 AND 28-2405, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2418, 28-2419, 28-2420, 28-2515, 28-6501, 28-6991 AND 28-6993, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2351, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 3 read:

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28-2351. License plate provided; design

A. The department shall provide to every owner one license plate for each vehicle registered. At the request of the owner and on payment of any required fee, the department shall provide either one or two license plates for a vehicle for which a special plate is requested pursuant to this chapter, except that the department shall provide one license plate if the special plate is issued pursuant to section <del>28-2404,</del> 28-2409 or 28-2416.

11 B. The license plate shall display the number assigned to the vehicle 12 and to the owner of the vehicle and the name of this state, which may be 13 abbreviated. The director shall coat the license plate with a reflective 14 material that is consistent with the determination of the license plate 15 commission established by section 28-2405 DEPARTMENT regarding the color and 16 design of license plates and special plates as prescribed by section 28-2405. 17 The director shall design the license plate and the letters and numerals on the license plate to be of sufficient size to be plainly readable during 18 19 daylight from a distance of one hundred feet. In addition to the standard 20 license plate issued for a trailer before August 12, 2005, the director shall 21 issue a license plate for trailers that has a design that is similar to the standard size license plate for trailers but that is the same size as the 22 23 license plate for motorcycles. The trailer owner shall notify the department 24 which size license plate the owner wants for the trailer.

C. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall not contract with a nongovernmental entity to purchase or secure reflective material for the plates issued by the department unless the department has made a reasonable effort to secure qualified bids or proposals from as many individual responsible respondents as possible.

D. The license plate commission established by section 28-2405 DEPARTMENT shall determine the color and design of the license plate. All other plates issued by the department, except the plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2412, 28-2413, 28-2414, 28-2416 through 28-2428, 28-2452, 28-2453, 28-2454 and 28-2455 and article 14 of this chapter, shall be the same color as and similar in design to the license plate as determined by the commission DEPARTMENT.

E. A passenger motor vehicle rented without a driver shall receive the same type of license plate as issued for a private passenger motor vehicle.

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Sec. 2. Section 28-2403, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 28-2403. <u>Special plates; transfers; violation; classification</u>

A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the department shall issue or renew special plates in lieu of the regular license plates pursuant to the following conditions and procedures and only if the requirements prescribed by this article for the requested special plates are met: 1 1. Except as provided in section 28-2416, a person who is the 2 registered owner of a vehicle registered with the department or who applies 3 for an original or renewal registration of a vehicle may submit to the 4 department a completed application form as prescribed by the department with 5 the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for special plates in addition to the 6 registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

2. Except for plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2412, 28-2413,
28-2414, 28-2416 through 28-2428, 28-2452, 28-2453, 28-2454 and 28-2455 and
article 14 of this chapter, the special plates shall be the same color as and
similar to the design of the regular license plates that is determined by the
license plate commission pursuant to section 28-2351 DEPARTMENT.

12 3. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall issue 13 special plates only to the owner or lessee of a vehicle that is currently 14 registered, including any vehicle that has a declared gross weight, as 15 defined in section 28-5431, of twenty-six thousand pounds or less.

4. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall charge
the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for each annual renewal of special
plates in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

19 B. Except as provided in section 28-2416, on notification to the 20 department and on payment of the transfer fee prescribed by section 28-2402, 21 a person who is issued special plates may transfer the special plates to 22 another vehicle the person owns or leases. Persons who are issued special 23 plates for hearing impaired persons pursuant to section 28-2408 and 24 international symbol of access special plates pursuant to section 28-2409 are 25 exempt from the transfer fee. If a person who is issued special plates 26 sells, trades or otherwise releases ownership of the vehicle on which the 27 plates have been displayed, the person shall immediately report the transfer 28 of the plates to the department or the person shall surrender the plates to 29 the department as prescribed by the director. It is unlawful for a person to 30 whom the plates have been issued to knowingly permit them to be displayed on 31 a vehicle except the vehicle authorized by the department.

32 C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES AUTHORIZED BY THE 33 LEGISLATURE IF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:

AN ORGANIZATION PAYS IMPLEMENTATION COSTS TO THE DEPARTMENT WITHIN
 ONE YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORIZATION.

36 2. THE ORGANIZATION SUBMITS AT LEAST ONE THOUSAND APPLICATIONS AND37 FEES IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

38 3. THE DESIGN AND FORMAT OF THE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO 39 THE APPROVAL OF THE LEGISLATURE IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR.

40 C. D. The special plates shall be affixed to the vehicle for which 41 registration is sought in lieu of the regular license plates.

42 43 D. E. A person is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor who:

1. Violates subsection B of this section.

Sec. 3. <u>Repeal</u>

2. Fraudulently gives false or fictitious information in the application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant to this article.

4 3. Conceals a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in the 5 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant to 6 this article.

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9 10 Sections 28-2404 and 28-2405, Arizona Revised Statutes, are repealed. Sec. 4. Section 28-2418, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 28-2418. <u>Navajo nation special plates</u>

A. If by June 30, 2003, the Navajo nation pays thirty-two thousand dollars to the department for the implementation of this section, The department shall issue Navajo nation special plates. The color and design of the Navajo nation special plates shall be different from the color and design of regular license plates determined by the license plate commission pursuant to section 28-2351 DEPARTMENT and shall be representative of the Navajo nation.

18 B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the 19 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a 20 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

21 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and 22 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund 23 established by section 28-6991 and shall transmit all donations collected 24 pursuant to this section to the Navajo nation department of highway safety. 25 The Navajo nation department of highway safety shall use these monies only 26 for traffic control devices that conform to the manual and specifications 27 prescribed in section 28-641 on highways on the Navajo reservation that are 28 located in this state and that are not state highways.

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Sec. 5. Section 28-2419, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 28-2419. <u>Transplantation awareness special plates: fund</u>

31 A. If, by June 30, 2004, a private coalition that is qualified under 32 section 501(c)(3) of the United States internal revenue code for federal 33 income tax purposes and that has a mission of promoting transplantation 34 awareness pays the department of transportation thirty two thousand dollars 35 for the implementation of this section The department shall issue 36 transplantation awareness special plates. The color and design of the 37 transplantation awareness special plates shall be different from the color 38 and design of regular license plates determined by the license plate 39 commission pursuant to section 28-2351 DEPARTMENT.

B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for
original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a
special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.
C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and
35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund

1 established by section 28-6991 and all donations collected pursuant to this 2 section in the transplantation awareness fund established by this section.

D. The transplantation awareness fund is established consisting of monies received pursuant to this section. The director shall administer the fund.

6 E. The director shall select a private coalition that is qualified 7 under section 501(c)(3) of the United States internal revenue code for 8 federal income tax purposes and that has a mission of promoting 9 transplantation awareness and allocate the monies in the fund to the 10 coalition on an annual basis.

11 F. On notice from the director, the state treasurer shall invest and 12 divest monies in the fund as provided by section 35-313, and monies earned 13 from investment shall be credited to the fund.

G. Monies in the fund are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190relating to lapsing of appropriations.

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Sec. 6. Section 28-2420, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 28-2420. <u>San Carlos Apache tribe special plates</u>

A. If by December 31, 2004, the San Carlos Apache tribe pays thirty-two thousand dollars to the department for the implementation of this section, The department shall issue San Carlos Apache tribe special plates. The color and design of the San Carlos Apache tribe special plates shall be different from the color and design of regular license plates determined by the <del>license plate commission pursuant to section 28-2351</del> DEPARTMENT and shall be representative of the San Carlos Apache tribe.

B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

28 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and 29 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund 30 established by section 28-6991 and shall transmit all donations collected 31 pursuant to this section to the San Carlos Apache tribe transportation board. The San Carlos Apache tribe transportation board shall use these monies only 32 33 for traffic control devices that conform to the manual and specifications 34 prescribed in section 28-641 on highways on the San Carlos Apache tribe 35 reservation that are located in this state and that are not state highways.

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Sec. 7. Section 28-2515, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 28-2515. <u>Taxis: license plates</u>

A. Subject to legislative appropriation, beginning on July 1, 2004, the department shall issue taxi special plates to the owner of every vehicle operating as a taxi.

41 B. Every vehicle operating as a taxi shall display a taxi special 42 plate issued by the department pursuant to this section.

43 C. The color and design of the taxi special plates shall be determined 44 by the <del>license plate commission</del> DEPARTMENT pursuant to section 28-2351 and 45 shall indicate that the vehicle is a taxi.

2	28-6501. Definition of highway user revenues

15	Sec. 9. Section 28–6991, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:
16	28–6991. <u>State highway fund; sources</u>
17	A state highway fund is established that consists of:
18	1. Monies distributed from the Arizona highway user revenue fund
19	pursuant to chapter 18 of this title.
20	2. Monies appropriated by the legislature.
21	3. Monies received from donations for the construction, improvement or
22	maintenance of state highways or bridges. These monies shall be credited to
23	a special account and shall be spent only for the purpose indicated by the
24	donor.
25	<ol><li>Monies received from counties under cooperative agreements,</li></ol>
26	including proceeds from bond issues. The state treasurer shall deposit these
27	monies to the credit of the fund in a special account on delivery to the
28	treasurer of a concise written agreement between the department and the
29	county stating the purposes for which the monies are surrendered by the
30	county, and these monies shall be spent only as stated in the agreement.
31	5. Monies received from the United States under an act of Congress to
32	provide aid for the construction of rural post roads, but monies received on
33	projects for which the monies necessary to be provided by this state are
34	wholly derived from sources mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this section
35	shall be allotted by the department and deposited by the state treasurer in
36	the special account within the fund established for each project. On

Except as provided in section 28-5101, the following monies: 10 (a) Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-2206 and section 28-5808, 11 subsection B, paragraph 2, subdivision (e). 12 (b) One dollar of each registration fee and one dollar of each title 13 fee collected pursuant to section 28-2003. Section 28-6993, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 31 read: 28-6993. <u>State highway fund; authorized uses</u> 32 33 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and section 28-6538, the state highway fund shall be used for any of the following 34 35 purposes in strict conformity with and subject to the budget as provided by this section and by sections 28-6997 through 28-7003: 36 37 1. To pay salaries, wages, necessary travel expenses and other 38 expenses of officers and employees of the department and the incidental 39 office expenses, including telegraph, telephone, postal and express charges 40 and printing, stationery and advertising expenses. 41 2. To pay for both: 42 (a) Equipment, supplies, machines, tools, department offices and 43 laboratories established by the department. 44 (b) The construction and repair of buildings or yards of the 45 department.

1 3. To pay the cost of both: (a) Engineering, construction, improvement and maintenance of state 2 3 highways and parts of highways forming state routes. To defray lawful expenses and costs required to administer and 14 carry out the intent, purposes and provisions of this title, including 15 repayment of obligations entered into pursuant to this title, payment of 16 interest on obligations entered into pursuant to this title, repayment of 17 loans and other financial assistance, including repayment of advances and 18 interest on advances made to the department pursuant to section 28-7677, and 19 payment of all other obligations and expenses of the board and department 20 pursuant to chapter 21 of this title. 21 8. offices, to cover the administrative costs of issuing the air quality compliance sticker, modifying the year validating tab and issuing the windshield sticker and to cover expenses and costs in issuing special plates pursuant to sections <del>28-2404,</del> 28-2412 through 28-2428 and 28-2514.

D. The department shall use monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to chapter 5, article 5 of this title only as prescribed by that article. 14

1 E. Monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to section 2 28-2269 shall be used only as prescribed by that section.

F. Monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to section 28-710, subsection D, paragraph 2 shall only be used for state highway work zone traffic control devices.

G. The department may exchange monies distributed to the state highway 6 7 fund pursuant to section 28-6538, subsection A, paragraph 1 for local government surface transportation program federal monies suballocated to 8 9 councils of government and metropolitan planning organizations if the local 10 government scheduled to receive the federal monies concurs. An exchange of 11 state highway fund monies pursuant to this subsection shall be in an amount 12 that is at least equal to ninety per cent of the federal obligation authority 13 that exists in the project for which the exchange is proposed.

Sec. 11. <u>Current special organization license plates</u>

Special organization license plates authorized and issued pursuant to section 28-2404, Arizona Revised Statutes, and published in the Arizona administrative code before the effective date of this act remain valid license plates issued by this state unless the legislature enacts legislation specifically terminating those license plates.
