

**Isaac Maund House**

1608 3rd Avenue

Columbus

The Isaac Maund House is located in a residential area composed primarily of 1890s shotgun houses. One of the more elaborate houses in this neighborhood, it was probably built by its original owner, Isaac Maund, a black mill worker who later became a carpenter. Located very near residences historically occupied by whites, this house illustrates how close black citizens and whites lived to one another in the late 1800s and early 1900s in some areas of town.
