On August 28, 2000, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Westcoast Gas Services Delaware (America) Inc. (WGSI Delaware) in DOE/FE Order No. 1622 ½ (Order 1622) to import up to 1000 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas, and to export up to 1000 Bcf of natural gas to Canada beginning on October 1, 2000, and extending through November 30, 2002.

On November 30, 2000, FE transferred the blanket import/export authorization granted in Order 1622 from WGSI to Engage Energy America Corp.^{2/}

On April 5, 2001, Engage Energy America L.L.C., a successor to Engage Energy America Corp. and a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business in Southfield,

Michigan, requested that FE change the name on the import authorization issued in Order No.1622 to Engage Energy America L.L.C.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the blanket import/export authorization granted by DOE/FE Order No. 1622, as amended in DOE/FE Order No. 1622-A, is
