By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. This Order dismisses the Request for Review filed by Scott County School District (Scott County), Forest, Mississippi, seeking review of a decision issued by the Universal Service Administrative Company's Schools and Libraries Division.¹ The Commission received Scott County's Request for Review on May 30, 2001.² Under section 54.720 of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed within 30 days of the issuance of the decision of which review is sought.³ Documents are considered to be filed with the Commission only upon receipt.⁴ Because the instant Request for Review was not filed within the specified 30-day period, it will be dismissed without further consideration.
