Subj: ANNUAL COAST GUARD INVITATIONAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Notice is to invite participation in the 2001 Annual Coast Guard Invitational Golf Tournament. Participation is open to all active duty, reserve, retired, auxiliary and civilian personnel of the Coast Guard as well as military and civilian dependents and guests.
2. ACTION. Area and district commanders, commanders of maintenance and logistics commands, commanding officers of headquarters units, assistant commandants for directorates, Chief Counsel, and special staff offices at Headquarters shall give this notice widest dissemination.
3. DISCUSSION.
 - a. This year's tournament will be held at the Daufuskie Resort in Hilton Head, South Carolina from 4-7 July 2001. This event is being held for the first time during the summer and over a holiday in an effort to encourage more participation by families. The sponsoring golf association for this year's tournament is the Coast Guard Headquarters Golf Association. The tournament will consist of one practice day on 4 July (including a team scramble event), followed by 3 days of individual stroke play. Participation is as noted above.
 - b. Enclosures (1) and (2) provide information about the Daufuskie Resort and explain the accommodations and entry procedures into the tournament. The entry forms may be locally reproduced.

DAUFUSKIE RESORT

GENERAL INFORMATION

Daufuskie Island, a Pinehurst Company Resort, is located on historic Daufuskie Island one mile off the coast of Hilton Head Island, South Carolina and is only accessible via one of the resort's private luxury passenger ferries.

NOTE: In order to arrive in time for the Wednesday afternoon Scramble event scheduled for 1345, you must be on the 1200 ferry from Hilton Head at the very latest! The ferries leave from the Daufuskie Island Embarkation Center every two hours on the EVEN hour (i.e., 0600, 0800, 1000, 1200, etc).

The resort features 186 rooms including elegant Inn rooms, as well as two- and four-bedroom marsh and ocean view cottages; four restaurants and lounges providing fine and casual dining experiences; the Island House, a 16,000-square-foot state-of-the-art executive conference center for groups of up to 300; and two championship golf courses. **Melrose Golf Course** - This Jack Nicklaus-designed signature course sweeps along the Atlantic Ocean, providing challenging play and stunning views. The three finishing holes hug the ocean, and number 18 seems to lunge straight into it with the beach in play the entire hole. **Bloody Point Golf Course** - This Tom Weiskopf/Jay Morrish-designed course, situated along the Mungen River, winds through Daufuskie's coastal marshes and dark-water lagoons. Its name may sound menacing; however, its layout is very playable and perfect for golfers of any level. Practice facilities located at both courses include a driving range, chipping and bunker green, and putting green.

In addition to the fabulous golf, Daufuskie is also a wonderful resort for families. The resort has three swimming pools and a Beach Club, extensive water sport activities, three miles of white sand, pristine beach, an equestrian center, a state-of-the-art Stan Smith-designed tennis center, supervised children's programs as well as numerous additional recreational activities and amenities.

LOCATION & DIRECTIONS

Daufuskie Island is easily accessible by ferry from their Embarkation Center on Hilton Head Island.

Directions from Savannah International Airport to Embarkation Center

(Approximately 45 minutes). Exit the airport via the I-95 North exit and continue on I-95 until you reach Exit 8 to Hilton Head Island. Proceed on Hwy. 278 about 20 miles to the Hilton Head Island bridge. Cross the bridge and continue approximately 1½ miles to Squire Pope Road (first traffic light over the bridge). Turn left on Squire Pope Road and follow this road, which becomes Seabrook Drive, until you reach Daufuskie Island Embarkation Center, located on your left, just before Hilton Head Plantation's Cypress Gate.

Directions from Hilton Head Airport to Embarkation Center

(Approximately 10 minutes). When exiting the airport turn left on Beach City Road and follow it to Hwy. 278. Turn right on Hwy. 278 and follow it to Gumtree Road. Turn right onto Gumtree Road and follow it to the stop sign. At the stop sign turn right onto Seabrook Drive and follow it until you reach Daufuskie Island Embarkation Center, located on your left, just before Hilton Head Plantation's Cypress Gate.

Directions from the North to Embarkation Center

Go south on I-95 to South Carolina until you reach Exit 8 to Hilton Head Island. Proceed on Hwy. 278 about 20 miles to the Hilton Head Island bridge. Cross the bridge and continue approximately 1½ miles to Squire Pope Road (first traffic light over the bridge). Turn left on Squire Pope Road and follow this road, which becomes Seabrook Drive, until you reach Daufuskie Island Embarkation Center, located on your left, just before Hilton Head Plantation's Cypress Gate.

Directions from the South to Embarkation Center

Go north on I-95 to South Carolina until you reach Exit 8 to Hilton Head Island. Proceed on Hwy. 278 about 20 miles to the Hilton Head Island bridge. Cross the bridge and continue approximately 1½ miles to Squire Pope Road (first traffic light over the bridge). Turn left on Squire Pope Road and follow this road, which becomes Seabrook Drive, until you reach Daufuskie Island Embarkation Center, located on your left, just before Hilton Head Plantation's Cypress Gate.

TOURNAMENT PACKAGES

For Tuesday evening, rooms are available for \$200 to \$211 per night plus the \$15 Guest Service Fee and tax. For Saturday evening, rooms are available for \$134 to \$144 per night plus the \$15 Guest Service Fee and tax.*)
- * Welcome barbecue on Wednesday evening.
- * Awards banquet at the conclusion of play on Saturday afternoon.
- * All taxes and gratuities.

Golfer package:

- * Three nights lodging (Wednesday, Thursday & Friday). (*Additional nights before or after the tournament can be reserved by contacting the resort @ 843-842-2000. See above for rates.*)
- * Four rounds of golf.

- * Additional rounds (following the tournament rounds Wed thru Sat) are \$25 per golfer for 18 holes (cart included).

- * Team Scramble event on Wednesday.
- * Welcome barbecue on Wednesday evening.
- * Awards banquet at the conclusion of play on Saturday afternoon.
- * Tournament registration fees.
- * Unlimited Range Balls
- * Cottage Cart for those living in Cottages. Note: One Cottage Cart (four passenger) for every 2 bedroom cottage will be provided to participants for the duration of the stay at no additional cost.
- * All taxes and gratuities (note: it is appropriate to tip ball/bag attendants on your own).
- * Arrival gifts/tournament prizes/door prizes.

Note: Children sharing room with parents receive free lodging and ferry service.

Please note that a Resort Guest Fee of \$15.00 per night per bedroom (\$45.00 total) will be billed separately and apportioned to each participant (**separate from the above package prices**) to cover unlimited ferry passage, luggage and golf bag handling, bell and maid staff gratuities, daily housekeeping, use of on property shuttle, croquet and lawn bowling, and use of the Beach Club pools and fitness center.

REGISTRATION/REFUNDS

Reservations for this tournament are on a first come, first served basis since there will be a limit to the number of golfers that can be accommodated on the golf course. All personnel wishing to participate (golfers and non-golfers) in this tournament must fill out an entry form and send it along with the appropriate entry fee to Dr. Mike Parnarouskis (see entry form) by 15 May 2001. On 21 May 2001, we must make our final commitment to the Daufuskie Resort and release all lodging units not reserved. Therefore, to be considered, all entry forms and fees must be received at Coast Guard Headquarters by 15 May.

After 30 May 2001, a portion of the deposit we pay to the Daufuskie Resort will have to be forfeited. The closer to the tournament date that an entry is cancelled, the larger the forfeiture will be. Entry forms

received after 15 May will only be considered if lodging at the resort is available and if the maximum number of golfers has not been reached.

FORMAT OF PLAY

The tournament will consist of 54 holes of medal play. No handicaps will be used. The field will be flighted and re-paired following the 2nd round. The 54 hole total score will determine all winners. The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants. Several prizes will be awarded in each flight. Prizes will also be awarded for other categories such as closest to the pins and longest drives, as funds will allow. No distinction will be made between the golfers, except that ladies will play the red tees. The Scramble Event for Wednesday will be a separate team event and the scores during that day will not be considered for the remainder of the tournament.
