ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM
AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO AND TO
IMPORT LNG FROM ANY COUNTRY

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1719-A

In DOE/FE Order No. 1719 (Order 1719)¹, issued in FE Docket No. 01-58-NG on October 16, 2001, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to PanCanadian Energy Services, Inc. to import and export natural gas from and to Canadian and Mexico, and to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from any foreign source over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2001, and extending through October 31, 2003. The combined total of all natural gas imports and exports, including imported LNG, will not exceed 500 billion cubic feet.

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On April 26, 2002, FE was notified that PanCanadian Energy Services, Inc.'s name had been

changed to EnCana Energy Services, Inc. effective April 8, 2002.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the blanket authorization granted by

DOE/FE Order No. 1719, is amended to substitute EnCana Energy Services, Inc. for PanCanadian

Energy Services, Inc. as the importer and export of natural gas, and the importer of LNG. All terms

and conditions in Order 1719 remain in full force and effect.
