S. 1728

Na Hoa Pili O Kaloko-Honokohau Advisory Commission Reauthorization Act of 2007

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources on July 25, 2007

S. 1728 would extend through December 31, 2017, the life of the Na Hoa Pili O Kaloko-Honokohau Advisory Commission. The previous authority for the commission expired in November 2006.

CBO estimates that implementing S. 1728 would have no significant effect on the federal budget and would not affect direct spending or revenues. In past years, the advisory commission has typically received funds from appropriations to the National Park Service of less than \$20,000 a year.

S. 1728 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
