## ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS, INCLUDING LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS, AND TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1829-A

In DOE/FE Order No. 1829 (Order 1829), issued in FE Docket No. 02-81-LNG on November 21, 2002, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Engage Energy America LLC to import up to 1000 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas (LNG), from Canada, and to export up to 1000 Bcf of natural gas to Canada over a two-year term beginning on December 1, 2002, and extending through November 30, 2004.

On November 12, 2003, FE was notified that the name Engage Energy America LLC had been changed to Engage Energy, LLC effective immediately.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the blanket authorization granted by DOE/FE Order No. 1829, is amended to substitute Engage Energy, LLC for Engage Energy America LLC as the importer of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas, and the exporter of natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 1829 remain in full force and effect.
