- Repacks of Certitied Color, Color Additives and Color Additives mixtures.
- (1) 100 lbs. or less \$30
- (2) over 100 lbs. \$30 plus \$.06 for each pound over 100 lbs., but not over 1000 lbs.
- (3) over 1000 lbs. \$84 plus \$.02 for each pound over 1000 lbs.
