

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- **(6684) Wagner, Frederick E.** Private. Co.I, 4 PA Art. Died 21 May, 1925. Wife, **Sallie May** died 7 May, 1939 and also buried in grave.
- (5223) Walch, Gilbert (SR has Welch) Private. Co.B, 122 NY. Age 22. Enlisted at Syracuse for three years and mustered in 8 Aug., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 16 Jan. (FVC has Jan 15), 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Robinson's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3951) Walcott, Harrison T. Captain. 40 NY. Age 20. Enlisted at Yonkers for three years and mustered in as a Corporal, Co.G, 21 Jun., 1861. Promoted to First Sergeant 1 Nov., 1862. Promoted to Second Lieutenant 1 Jan., 1863 and mustered in 13 Feb., 1863. Mustered in as First Lieutenant, Co.H, 1 Jul., 1863. Promoted Captain Co.A, 24 Nov., 1863. Transferred to Co.G, 30 Apr., 1864. Killed in action 5 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3623) Waldron, John T. Private. Co.H, 20 MI. Age 21. Res Olivet. Enlisted 12 Aug., 1862 at Olivet for three years and mustered in 19 Aug., 1862. Killed in action at North Anna 26 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Bibb's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (**5012**) **Waldron, John A.** Private. Co.G, 122 NY. Age -5. Enlisted 11 Aug., 1862 at Elbridge for three years and mustered in 16 Aug., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 27 Dec., 1862 at camp near Falmouth (FVC has 21 Dec, 1862) (SR). Originally buried at Robinson's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (2738) Walker, Alexander J. Private. Co.B, 3 NJ. Enlisted and mustered in 25 May, 1861 for three years. Died at Fredericksburg 12 May, 1863 of wounds recieved at Salem Heights 3 May, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Lacy's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (491) Walker, George A. Private. Co.E, 4 MI. Age -25. Res Litchfield. Enlisted 25 Aug., 1862 at Hillsdale. Missing in action at Gettysburg 2 Jul., 1863. Prisoner. Returned to Annapolis 10 Dec., 1863. Died of wounds received at Spotsylvania May 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Hart's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (6674) Walker, George B. Sergeant. Batt. A, 18 U.S. Died 27 Apr., 1921.
- (3002) Walker, George R. Private. Co.B, 61 PA. Mustered in 1 Aug., 1861 for three years. Killed at the Wilderness May 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3030) Walker, John F. Private. Co.I, 104 NY. Age 19. Enlisted 5 Feb., 1862 at Troy for three years. Mustered in 13 Feb., 1862. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 near Spotsylvania Court House (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4407) Walker, Roswell A. Corporal. Co.C, 132 PA. Mustered in 11 Aug., 1862 for nine months. Died at Belle Plain 7 Dec., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Belle Plain Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3931) Walkin, William (SR has Mulkins) Private. Co.H, 105 PA. Mustered in 12 Sept., 1861 for three years. Died 7 May, 1864 of wounds received at the Wilderness 5 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (1186) Wall, Richard Corporal. Co.K, 79 NY. Age 18. Enlisted 13 May, 1861 at New York City for three years. Mustered in as a Private 27 May, 1861. Promoted to Corporal 1 Nov., 1863. Killed in action 9 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania Court House (SR). Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4255) Wallace, A.K.P. Captain. Co.B, 31 ME. Age 39. Res Millbridge. Mustered in 8 Mar., 1864. Killed at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5237) Wallace, Daniel Private. Co.E, 2 VT. Age 45. Res Strafford. Enlisted 27 Aug., 1862 and mustered in 27 Sept., 1862. Died 26 Jan., 1863 of disease (SR). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).
- (5750) Wallace, Edward C. Private. Co.C, 39 PA. Mustered in 21 Jul., 1861 for three years. Died 1 Jan., 1863 at Belle Plain Hospital (SR). Originally buried at Anderson's Farm, King George (ROH).
- (4985) Wallace, Henry Private. Co.D, 149 PA. Mustered in 23 Aug., 1862 for three years. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 10 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (4153) Wallace John Private. U.S. Vol. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Center Branch Hospital, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4641) Wallace, Urlas (FVC has Urias) Private. Co.F, 122 PA. Age 22. Enlisted 4 Aug., 1862 at Lancaster City for nine months and mustered in 11 Aug., 1862. Died 20 Mar., 1863 at camp near Falmouth of Typhoid Fever (NARA). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (2571) Walsh, Frank (SR has Welsher) Private. Co.A, 108 NY. Age 24. Enlisted at Rochester for three years and mustered in 19 Jul., 1862. Wounded in action 17 Sept., 1862 at Antietam. Died of disease 31 May, 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Lacy's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4165) Walsh, James (SR has Welsh) Private. Co.B, 51 NY. Age 35. Enlisted at East Bloomfield for three years and mustered in 15 Apr., 1864. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (1041) Walsh, William Private. Co.A, 37 NY. Age 27. Enlisted 9 May, 1861 at New York City for three years and mustered in 6 Jun., 1861. Mustered out with company 22 Jun., 1863 at New York City (SR). FVC states he died 18 Feb., 1865. Originally buried at Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (3404) Walters, John Private. 140 PA. Died May 1863. Originally buried at Mrs. Smith's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5942) Walts, O.F. Private. Co.G, 3 NY. Died 11 May, 1864. Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4736) Wanner (see Wunner)
- (876) Ward, H. Private. Co.I, 69 PA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (353) Ward, J.H. Private. Co.D, 19 MA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5893) Warmby, Thomas (SR has Wharmby, Samuel) Private. Co.F, 145 NY. Age 21. Enlisted 9 Aug., 1862 at New York City for three years and mustered in 11 Sept., 1862. Wounded in back at Chancellorsville 3 May, 1863. Admitted to 12 Corps Hospital, Aquia Creek 4 May, 1863. Died 12 May, 1863 of his wounds (SR). Not in ROH.
- (4913) Warner, John Corporal. Co.H, 12 NY. Age 21. Enlisted 30 Apr., 1861 at Syracuse for two years. Mustered into Co.B as a Private 13 May, 1861. Transferred to Co.H 3 Feb., 1862. Promoted to Corporal (no date). Killed in action at Fredericksburg 13 Dec., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Cunningham's Farm, Stafford (ROH). Original marker said War______R. New stone has been placed there and corrected.
- **(4971)** Warner, Theodore F. Private. Co.D, 50 PA. Mustered in 6 Sept., 1861 at Montrose for three years. Died 12 May, 1864 of wounds received in action (SR). FVC has Jan. 1864. Originally buried at Allen's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (5982) Warner, George D. Private. Co.C, 151 PA. Age 37. Enlisted 23 Sept., 1862 at Montrose for nine months and mustered in 20 Oct., 1862. Taken to Windmill Point Hospital 20 Apr., 1863 and died there 13 May, 1863 of fever (NARA). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).

- (4705) Warren, Abel Private. Co.B, 11 PA. Died 29 Mar., 1863. Originally buried at Roy's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (5181) Warring, George E. Corporal. Co.D, 61 PA. Age 18. Born Tompkins Co., NY. Enlisted 18 Aug., 1861 at Wilkes Barre for three years and mustered into Co.L, 23 PA 4 Sept., 1861. Appointed Corporal Nov, 1861. Transferred to Co.D, 61 PA (no date). Discharged on Surgeon's Certification of sability 9 May, 1863 and died 10 Mar, 1864 (NARA). Originally buried at Robinson's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (298) Washburn, Eleazer Private. Co.F, 1 MA H.Art. Age 21. Occ Farmer. Res Teamworth, NH. Enlisted and mustered in 5 Jul., 1861. Re-enlisted 5 Nov., 1863. Killed 19 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania. Buried as Washbury (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4689B) Washington, Howard Private.2nd Co. 155 Dep. Brig. Died 7 May, 1945.
- (3863) Waters, Louis Francis (also Waters, Lewis) Captain. Co.D, 99 PA. Age 28. Enlisted and mustered into Co.E as a First Sergeant 24 Aug., 1861 at Philadelphia for three years. Promoted to Second Lieutenant of Co.I, 13 Sept., 1862. Wounded in action 13 Dec., 1862 and sent to hospital 16 Dec, 1862. Promoted to First Lieutenant 1 Jan., 1863 and in command of company 27 Feb., 1863. Promoted to Captain 13 Nov., 1863. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (NARA). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5059) Watkins, Albert T. Private. Co.E, 141 PA. Mustered in 25 Aug., 1862 for three years. Died near Falmouth 27 Nov., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Roy's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4893) Watkins, Charles Private. Co.G, 11 U.S. Died 11 May, 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4832) Watson, Alpheus D. Private. Co.F, 107 NY. Age 19. Enlisted 4 Aug., 1862 at Addison for three years and mustered in 5 Aug., 1862. Died of putrid sore throat 21 Mar., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Hope Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (2859) Watson, Abraham Private. Co.C, 14 IN. Res Martin Co. Mustered in 7 Jun., 1861. Appointed Corporal. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Episcopal Churchyard, Fredericksburg (ROH). ROH states he died in 1862.

- (6755) Way, Robert Private. Co.F, 3 Va. Inf. Span. Amer. Discharged 5 Nov., 1898. Died 9 Oct, 1943.
- (5068) We____, James Sergeant. U.S. Vol. Died 13 Jan, 1863. Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3281) Weatherby, Hamilton Private. Co.C, 111 NY. Age 18. Enlisted 5 Aug., 1862 at Victory for three years and mustered in 20 Aug., 1862. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Cook's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- **(532) Weaver, George H.** Private. 19 NY Batt. Age 21. Enlisted and mustered in 27 Aug., 1862 at Lockport for three years. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3749) Weaver, Henry C. Private. Co.C, 8 MI. Age 18. Res Gratiot Co. Enlisted 12 Aug., 1861 at Alma for three years and mustered in 23 Sept., 1861. Re-enlisted 29 Dec., 1863 at Blain's Crossroads, TN, and mustered in 30 Dec., 1863. Wounded in action at Bull Run. Killed in action at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3187) Weaver, J. Private. Co.I, 61 PA. Mustered in at Philadelphia for three years. Killed in action at the Wilderness May 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5640) Webb, Franklin (SR has Francis) Private. Co.H, 38 PA (9 PA RC). Mustered in 26 Aug., 1861 for three years. Died at Windmill Point 7 Feb., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).
- (2422) Webb, James W. Private. Co.G, 6 WI. Res Beloit. Mustered in 31 May, 1861. Wounded in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness. Died 19 May, 1864 at Fredericksburg (SR). Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (2855) Webb, John Private. Co.A, 1 DE. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Episcopal Churchyard, Fredericksburg (ROH). As of 5/27/98 DE files are not available, check later.
- (6710) Webb, Onie Private. Barracks Detachment. Marine Corps. Enlisted 5 Jan., 1917. Discharged 26 March, 1921. Died 10 Feb., 1934.
- **(6721) Weber, Thomas H.** Private. Co.I, 22 U.S. Reg. Enlisted 14 Dec., 1898. Discharged 12 April, 1901. Died 27 Mar, 1935.
- (6018) Webster, Barnham Private. At age 44 enlisted in Co.G, 161 NY at Binghamton for 3 years. Mustered out Sept. 20, 1865. Murdered at Guinna Station, VA. 13 Feb. 1872. Check might be Burnham.
- (5030) Webster, John Private. Co.E, 3 MI. Age 34. Res Rutland. Drafted 10 Feb., 1863 at Rutland for nine months. Joined regiment at Camp Pitcher, VA 10 Mar., 1863. Died of disease at Camp Sickles 6 Apr., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Bullard's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (993) Weeks, William W. Sergeant. Co.B, 183 PA. Mustered in 9 Feb., 1864 for three years. Killed in action at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5752) Weiddman, Carl Private. Batt.L, NY Art. Died 22 Nov., 1862. Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4706) Weiger, George Private. Co.H, PA Vol. Died 29 Nov., 1862. Originally buried at Roy's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

- (4939) Westcoat, David A. Sergeant. Co.H, 28 NJ. Enlisted 1 Sept., 1862 for nine months and mustered in 22 Sept., 1862. Died of fever at a hospital near Falmouth 11 Mar., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Douglas's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (5005) Westley, Joseph (SR has Wesley) Private. Co.A, 1 MD. Enlisted 14 Aug, 1862. Wounded 19 May, 1864 at Harris Farm. Died May 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wallace's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (1108) Wetherbee, Charles W. (FVC has Wetherbee, S.N.) Private. Co.E, 33 MA. Age 22. Occ Cooper. Res Townsend. Enlisted 22 Jul., 1862 and mustered in 5 Aug., 1862. Died of disease 29 Dec., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Bernard's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2117) Wetzel, Henry H. (ROH has Vetze) Private. Co.G, 155 PA. Mustered in 28 Aug., 1862 for three years. Died 21 Dec., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3083) Whalen, Dennis Private. Co.D, 82 PA. Mustered in 12 Aug., 1861 for three years. Died at Hanover Court House 26 May, 1865 (FVC has May 27, 1864)(SR). Originally buried at Clifford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4129) Whaler, John (SR has Wheelan) Private. Co. G, 73 NY (4 NY excel.). Mustered into 163 NY. Transferred to Co.G, 73 NY 18 Jan., 1863. Killed in action 5 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4916) Whealon, Daniel Private. Co.K, 72 NY (3 NY excel). Age 27. Enlisted at New York City for three years and mustered into Co.L 14 Nov., 1861. Transferred to Co.K, 25 Feb., 1862. Died of disease 16 Apr., 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3008) Wheeler, John Private. Co.K, 152 NY. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5173) Wheeler, L. Private. U.S. Vol. Died 1862. Originally buried at Pollock's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

- (5232) Wheeler, Marcus G. Private. Co.F, 24 MI. Age 30. Res Detroit. Enlisted 8 Aug, 1862 at Detroit for three years and mustered in 15 Aug, 1862. Died of disease at Belle Plain 29 Dec, 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Wallace's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (6725) Wheeler, Richard Private. Co.K, 3 VA Inf. Enlisted 26 April, 1898. Discharged 6 Nov. 1898. Died 25 Sep, 1936.
- (1162) Whitcomb, Albert Private. Co.B, 17 VT. Age 18. Res Essex. Enlisted 16 Feb., 1864 and mustered in 1 Mar., 1864. Died 15 May, 1864 of wounds received in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3095) Whitcomb, Lerman Corporal. Co.B, 9 __. Died 12 May, 1864. Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2615) Whitcomb, Nathan Private. Co.H, 9 NH. Age 43. Born in Canada. Enlisted 9 Aug., 1862 and mustered in 13 Aug., 1862. Wounded 13 Dec., 1862 at Fredericksburg. Died of disease 7 Feb., 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (1048) White, _____. Private. U.S.A. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3680) White, Charles (SR has Whittaker) Private. Co.H, 18 MA. Age 27. Occ Clerk. Res New York. Drafted and mustered in 8 Jul, 1863. Killed 5 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5712) White, George Private. Co.F, 130 PA. Mustered in 9 Aug, 1862 for nine months. Died at Windmill Point 4 Feb, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).
- (6735) White, George Larsen Fireman 1st class. U.S. Navy. Discharged 13 Oct., 1919. Died 6 Oct, 1938.
- (2613) White, Hugh Private. Co.C, 24 NJ. Enlisted 30 Aug, 1862 for nine months and mustered in 16 Sep, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at camp near Falmouth 25 Jan, 1863 (SR). Headstone has NH for the unit. Originally buried at O'Bannon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (5192) White, J. Private. Co.I, 11 PA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2708) White, John Private. Co.E, 84 NY. Age 35. Enlisted at Brooklyn for three years and mustered into Co.D, 8 Sept., 1862. Transferred to Co.E 13 Nov., 1862. Killed in action 10 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (**6746**) **White, John G.** Sergeant. Co.K, 116 Va.Inf. 29 Div. Discharged 24 June, 1919. Died 6 Oct., 1941.
- (2179) White, Joseph Private. 51 MA. Died 23 May, 1864. Originally buried at Marye's Heights, Fredericksburg (ROH) Possibly same as: White, Joseph Corporal. Co.I, 57 MA. Age 21. Occ Blacksmith. Res West Boylston. Enlisted 25 Feb., 1864 and mustered in 10 Mar., 1864. Killed 18 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR).

- (2129) White, Oscar Private. Co.A, 12 NY. Age 23. Enlisted 1 Dec., 1861 at Syracuse for two years and mustered into Co. E. Transferred to Co.A, 3 Feb., 1862. Died of disease 13 Dec., 1862 at regimental hospital (SR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4257) White, Ithiel I. Private. Co.K, 9 NH. Age 24. Res Cornish. Killed 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- **(4714) White, William** Private. Co.I, 18 PA (3 month reg). Died 14 Jan., 1863. Originally buried at Washington's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (317) Whitehead, Freeman Private. Co.I, 97 NY. Age 26. Enlisted at Harmony for three years, mustered in 19 Aug., 1863. Wounded in action 13 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill. Rolls list him as absent sick in hospital at Baltimore, MD at muster out of company (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (**7 officer section**) Whitehouse, Edwin Hayes. 1st Lieutenant. Co.G, 11th Va. Inf. Div. Discharged 16 July 1919. Died 27 Apr., 1941. Wife buried in same grave. Name unknown.
- (7) Whitfield, George E. Private. Co.C, 17 VT. Age 24. Res Johnson. Enlisted 26 Feb., 1864 and mustered in 2 Mar., 1864. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH). ROH lists him as from the VA Vol. regiment.
- (3797) Whiting, C. Private. Co.C, 12 U.S.A. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3779) Whiting, T.H. Private. 12 U.S.A. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4618) Whitman, Joseph P. (SR has Wightman) Private. Co.I, 124 NY. Age 31. Enlisted 18 Aug., 1862 at Newburgh for three years and mustered in 5 Sept., 1862.
