- (1300) Rall, W. Private. Co.K, 14 CT. Died May 1863. Originally buried at O'Bannon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (2717) Ramay, Edward (ROH has Ranney) Private. Co.K, 7 WI. Res St. Lawrence. Enlisted and mustered in 22 Jan, 1864. Killed 12 May (FVC has 8 May), 1864 at Laurel Hill (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- **(4898) Rand, Edward T.** Private. Co.A, 11 NH. Age 27. Res South Newmarket. Born Rye. Enlisted 13 Aug, 1862 and mustered in 28 Aug, 1862. Wounded 13 Dec, 1862 at Fredericksburg (SR). Admitted to 1st Div. 5th Corps Hospital near Falmouth with gunshot wound to the leg 13 or 14 Dec, 1862, and died 15 Dec, 1862 (HR). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (1900) Randall, George Private. Co.K, 124 NY. Age 19. Enlisted 21 Aug, 1862 at Wallkill for three years and mustered in 5 Sept, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 28 Dec, 1863 at camp near Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Primmer's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (2403) Rangott, Arthur O. Private. Co.G, 2 WI. Age 19. Occ Trunkman. Res Racine. Enlisted 23 Apr, 1861. Promoted Corporal 1 Nov, 1862. Killed in action 13 Dec, 1862 at Fredericksburg (SR). Originally buried at Allsop's Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (**5221**) **Rankin, William** Sergeant. Co.H, 84 NY (also known as 14<sup>th</sup> Brooklyn). Enlisted 18 Apr, 1861 at Brooklyn. Killed in battle 8 May, 1864, while acting as standard bearer at Spotsylvania/Laurel Hill battlefield. Father **James** and brothers **Edwin and James** also served in army. Many letters in pension file (NARA). Also sited in "*The History of the Fighting Fourteenth*", pg. 120: [in speaking of **Sgt. Rankin's** death at the Battle of Spotslyvania Court House] "It was in this fight, in

- the right wing of the regiment, that **Sergeant Rankin** was killed. This comrade was beloved by the whole regiment. He was a worthy type of brave Union soldier and a representative member of the Fourteenth. He had served with the regiment through all the battles it had participated in and his record had won him the deep respect of all the officers and the men. When the Grand Army of the Republic [a fraternal organization of Union veterans] came into existence, the first post was named in honor of **Sergeant Rankin** and became known as the 'Mother of Posts' in Brooklyn." **Rankin** was originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (2668) Rautley, H. Private. Co.A, 111 PA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Camback's Mill, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4198) Ray, C.L. Private. U.S. Vol. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Center Branch Hospital, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2769) Ray, James H. Private. Co.H, 15 MA. Age 24. Occ Laborer. Drafted and mustered in 5 Aug, 1863. Died 15 May, 1864 of wounds received in action at Spotsylvania 10 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at the Episcopal Churchyard, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (5696) Raymond, N. Private. Co.H, 119 NY. Died 29 Dec, 1862. Originally buried at Stafford Court House, Stafford (ROH).
- (5390) Records, William. H. Private. Co.E, 2 RI. Age 28. Occ Seaman. Res Scituate. Enlisted and mustered in 23 Sept, 1862. Died 20 Mar, 1863 at Falmouth, of Typhoid Fever (Reg). Originally buried at Sullivan's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- **(5479) Reece, Thomas** Private. Co.D, 155 PA. Mustered in 23 Aug, 1862. Died near Falmouth 1 or 2 Dec, 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Robert Smith's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (314) Reed, John M. Sergeant. Co.B, 24 MI. Age 29. Res Detroit. Enlisted 25 Jul, 1862 at Detroit for three years. Mustered in as a Corporal 3 Aug, 1862. Died 12 May, 1864 of wounds received in action at Spotsylvania Court House (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4935) Reede, E.W. Private. Co.B, 55 OH. Died 1863. Originally buried at Brook's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4837) Reek, Herbert Private. U.S. Vol. Died 1862. Originally buried at Henry's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (5479) Rees, Thomas (see Reece)
- (581) Reese, Hiram C. Private. Co.I, 110 OH. Age 18. Enlisted 22 Aug, 1862 for three years. Captured 9 Jul, 1864 at the Battle of Monocacy, MD. Listed as mustered out 11 Jul, 1865 by order of War Department (SR). FVC states he died May 1864. ROH states he was originally buried at Carter's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (3782) Reese, James Private. Co.B, 109 NY. Age 26. Enlisted 6 Aug, 1862 at Candor for three years and mustered in 11 Aug, 1862. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (4045) Reese, James M. Private. Co.K, 2 MI. Age 18. Enlisted 10 May, 1861 at Kalamazoo for three years and mustered in 25 May, 1861. Wounded in action at Knoxville, TN 24 Nov, 1863. Reenlisted 31 Dec, 1863 at Blain's Cross Roads, TN, and mustered in 1 Jan, 1864. Killed in action at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5573) Reeves, Willard Private. 4 ME. There is a great deal of controversy over when and where Reeves died. His children contend that he committed suicide because he "went insane due to time spent in Libby Prison" and that he was paroled "both physically and mentally sick." In a letter dated 26 Jul, 1898, the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Pensions state he committed suicide in Dec 1862, while the evidence in the pension file show his date of death as 4 Dec, 1863. Other letters in the file show that he died 14 Feb, 1863 in Newcastle, ME. He was last shown present with his company 30 Jun, 1862, but there are also files which state he never enlisted, never mustered, and not on rolls (NARA). Originally buried at Hansborough's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3985) Reger, E. Sergeant. Co.A, 31 PA. Age 31. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3348) Reger, Edwin H. Private. Co.C, 15 NJ. Enlisted and mustered in 27 Feb, 1864 for three years. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3731) **Reilly, Michael** Private. Co.C, 50 PA. Mustered in 9 Sep, 1861 for three years. Killed at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3940) Reiner, John D.S. (ROH has Rains, John D.) Private. Co.I, 143 PA. Age 33. Occ Laborer. Born Franklin. Drafted 11 Sept, 1863 at Chambersburg for three years and mustered in 11 Sept, 1863. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness by a minnie ball (NARA). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5380) Reinhart, Henry Private. Co.A, 96 PA. Enlisted 22 Aug, 1861 at Pottsville for three years and mustered in 23 Sept, 1861. Died at a regimental hospital near White Oak Church 23 Mar, 1863 of chronic diahrea. Husband of Lavinia (NARA). Originally buried at Shelton's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (1855) Reinhart, William P. Sergeant. Co.F, U.S. Enlisted 22 Feb, 1862 at New San Diego for five years and mustered into Co.F, 6 Inf. Died 24 Mar, 1863 of inflamation of the bowels, at camp near Potomac Creek (NARA). Originally buried at Henry's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3259) Reinoehl, William B. (Bates has Reynolds) Private. Co. B, 96 PA. Mustered in 23 Sept, 1861 in Schuylkill Co. for three years. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 10 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2454) Reisser, \_\_\_\_\_. Private. Co.G, U.S. Vol. Died May 1864. Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (277) Remick, Charles H. Private. Co.B, 1 MA H. Art. Age 21. Occ Carpenter. Res Haverhill. Enlisted and mustered in 7 Aug, 1862. Killed 19 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- **(4164) Remick, George W.** Private. Co.A, 32 ME. Age 36. Res Kittery. Mustered in 3 Mar, 1864. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2800) Reynolds, Edward Captain. Co.D, 51 NY. Age 34. Enrolled 3 Aug, 1861 at New York City for three years. Mustered in as a First Lieutenant, Co.D, 59 NY, 18 Sept, 1861. Promoted to Captain 1 May, 1862. Wounded in action 11 Dec, 1862 at Fredericksburg and died of his wounds 24 Dec, 1862 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Ireland's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (760) Reynolds, Joshua H. Private. Co.F, 27 MI. Age 32. Res Encorse. Enlisted 14 Sept, 1863 at Encorse for three years and mustered in 6 Nov, 1863 at Louisville, KY. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2513) Reynolds, John H. Private. Co.I, 83 PA. Res Crawford. Enlisted 28 Mar, 1864 at Meadville for three years and mustered in 31 Mar, 1864. Wounded 8 May, 1864 at the Wilderness and sent to a hospital where he died from the same wounds 25 May, 1864. Husband of **Sarah** (NARA). Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (5113) Reynolds, John N. Private. Co.F, 141 PA. Age 45. Mustered in 25 Aug, 1862. Died of chronic diahrea near Washington D.C. 29 Mar, 1863. Son of **Joshua Hatfield Reynolds** (SR). Originally buried at Ray's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4048) Rheinhard, Jacob Private. Co.B, 17 MI. Age 25. Enlisted 20 Feb, 1864 at Ashford for three years and mustered in 29 Feb, 1864. Killed in action at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- **(6704) Rhoads, Clarence** Private. Co.A, 193 NY. Buried 16 Dec, 1931. First wife **Mary Jane**, died 1886, and second wife **Helena** died 19 Jan, 1939, in same grave.
- (3249) Rhodes, S. Private. Co.E, 98 PA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5877) Ri\_gon, John B. (rank not stated). Co.A, U.S. Vol. Died 29 May, 1863. Originally buried at Hedgeman's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (4460) Rice, Edson Captain. Co. A., 57 PA. Res Wyoming Co. Mustered-in as 1st Lieutenant 4 Dec., 1861 for three years. Wounded at Fair Oaks 31 May, 1862. Promoted from 2<sup>nd</sup> to First Lt., 15 Dec., 1862. Made Captain, Co. E, 28 Feb., 1863. Killed at Chancellorsville, 3 May, 1863 (REG). Originally buried at Chancellorsville (ROH).
- (4343) Rice, Edward E. Private. Co.D, 93 NY. Age -18. Enlisted at Oranville for three years and mustered in 25 Mar, 1864. Wounded in action 5 May, 1864 at the Wilderness. Died of his wounds 10 May, 1864 in a field hospital near Petersburg (Reg). Originally buried at Center Branch Hospital, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (2252) Rice, Emery L. Private. Co.C, 57 MA. Age 18. Occ Farmer. Res Northampton. Enlisted 28 Jan, 1864. Mustered in 18 Feb, 1864. Killed 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5677) Rice, David A. Private. Co. B, 108 NY. Age 23. Enlisted at Rochester for three years. Mustered in 30 Jul., 1862. Died of disease in Apr., 1863 (Reg.). Originally buried at Arnold's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (3538) Rice, John Private. Co.C, 45 PA. Age 19. Occ Blacksmith. Born Mifflin Co. Enlisted 31 Aug, 1861 at Bellville for three years and mustered in 28 Sept or 28 Oct, 1861. Re-enlisted 1 Jan, 1864 at Blain's Crossroads, TN, for three years. Promoted to Corporal 1 Apr, 1864. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness by a rifle ball (NARA). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (1159) Rice, John. E. Private. Co.H, 7 RI. Res Warwick. Enlisted 15 Aug, 1862 and mustered in 4 Sept, 1862. 13 Jul, 1863 slightly wounded in battle near Jackson, Miss. 18 May, 1864 killed in action. Originally buried at Harris' Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (1161) Rice, Samuel Edward Sergeant. Co.H 7 RI. Occ Soldier. Res East Greenwich. Enlisted 15 Aug, 1862 and mustered in as a Corporal 14 Sept, 1862. Killed in action on 18 May, 1864. Only son of Samuel R. and Sarah Rice (Reg). Originally buried at Harris' Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3895) Richards, Charles L. Private. U.S. Vol. Died 21 May, 1864. Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (3126) Richards, Daniel Corporal. Co. E, 15 NJ. Enlisted 6 Aug., 1862. Mustered in 25 Aug., 1862 for three years. Promoted Corporal 22 Apr., 1863. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3777) Richards, Jason A. Private. Co.E, 44 NY. Age 19. Enlisted 28 Aug, 1862 at Wheatland for three years and mustered in 25 Sept, 1862. Wounded in action 5 May, 1864 and died of his wounds 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (Reg). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (1840) Richards, Liberty Private. Co.C, 13 NH. Age 43. Res Farmington. Born Leeds, ME. Mustered in 19 Sept, 1862. Died of disease at Fredericksburg 26 Dec, 1862 (Reg). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (1127) Richards, William F. Private. Co.F, 24 NJ. Enlisted 2 Sept, 1862 and mustered in 16 Sept, 1862 for nine months. Died of Typhoid Fever at a regimental hospital near Falmouth 15 Jan, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at O'Bannon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
- (**5994**) **Richardson, S.M.** Private. Co.A, 1 MA H. Art. Died 20 May, 1864. Originally buried at Goolrich's Field, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (1955) Richmond, Henry H. Private. Co.G, 12 NJ. Enlisted 25 Aug, 1862 for three years and mustered in 4 Sept, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at camp near Falmouth 13 Jan, 1863 (SR). Note: FVC states year of death as 1862. Originally buried at Mrs. Coon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

- (1668) Ricker, Edward C. Private. Co. A, 33 MA. Age 25. Occ Shoemaker. Res Groveland. Mustered in 9 Aug, 1862 for three years. Died 1 Jan, 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Note: FVC lists NY as Company. Originally buried at Falmouth Grounds, Stafford (ROH).
- (2190) Ricks, Henry (FVC has Rics) Private. Co.A, 149 NY. Enlisted 2 Sept, 1862 at Syracuse for three years and mustered in 2 Sept, 1862. Fell ill approximately 9 Feb, 1863. Admitted to hospital at Aquia Creek 16 Feb, 1863 and died 24 Feb, 1863 of Typhoid Fever. Son of Henry and Elizabeth (NARA). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).
- (4528) Rideout, Eben Private. Co.H, 16 ME. Age 28. Res Mais Hill. Mustered 14 Aug, 1862. Died 4 Apr, 1863 in camp (SR). Originally buried at Cross's Farm, North Anna River (ROH).
- (2190) Rider, Henry W. Private. Co. B, 1 ME H. Art. Age 25. Res Bradford. Mustered 9 Dec, 1863. Died 22 May, 1864 of wounds received at Spotsylvania 19 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Marye's Heights, Fredericksburg (ROH).
- (4405) Rider, Wesley Silvester Private. Co.H, 132 PA. Age 20. Enlisted 6 Aug, 1862 at Catawissa for nine months. Died 19 Dec, 1862 at Belle Plain Hospital of Typhoid Fever. Son of **Daniel and Sarah**. Note: by parents knowledge he had no middle name, so he may have added it himself (NARA). Not in ROH.
- (3216) Ridgeway, John (ROH has Ridgway) Private. Co.C, 121 PA. Age 40. Mustered in 15 Aug, 1862 for three years. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 10 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (Reg).
- (1988) Ridgway, Richard S. Sergeant. Co.I, 119 PA. Mustered in 30 Aug, 1862 for three years. Promoted to Sergeant 1 Sept, 1862 and First Sergeant 1 Mar, 1863. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (295) Riegle, Simon R. Private. Co.A, 50 PA. Age 25. Occ Shoemaker. Born Northumberland Co. Enlisted and mustered in 29 Feb, 1864 at Harrisburg for three years. Killed in action at the Battle of Ni River (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

Captured in action 2 Jul, 1863 at Gettysburg. Returned to Company 7 Oct, 1863. Re-enlisted 31 Dec, 1863. Promoted to Corporal (no date). Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Mule Shoe Salient (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

- (3677) Ritsaw, John (ROH has Ritsan) Private. Co.G, 84 PA. Age 21. Occ Farmer. Born North Middleton. Enlisted 23 Aug, 1862. Captured at Fredericksburg 3 May, 1863 and confined in Richmond 9 May, 1863. Paroled at City Point 15 May, 1863 and reported to Camp Parole, MD 18 May, 1863. Sent to Regiment 5 Oct, 1863. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania by a gunshot through the head. Husband of Amanda Catherine Cook (NARA). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (5079) Ritter, Morris Private. Co.K, 140 NY. Age 19. Enlisted 22 Aug, 1862 at Rochester for three years and mustered in 13 Sept, 1862. Killed in action 8 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill while with 4 other members of Co.K, went into no-mans land to try to bring in a still breathing Colonel George Ryan, all were killed (Reg). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (**522**) **Rivard, Moses** Private. Co.A, 57 MA. Age 18. Res Grafton. Born Montgomery, NY. Enlisted 26 Dec, 1863 at Worchester and mustered in 4 Jan, 1864. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (3363) Roach, James H. Private. Co.E, 45 PA. Enlisted 10 Mar, 1864 for three years and mustered in 11 Mar, 1864. Killed at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).
- (2424) Roach, James T. Private. Co.A, 8 MD. Age 18. Occ Farmer. Born Cecil Co. Enlisted and mustered in 13 Aug, 1862. Wounded in action (shot in left leg) at the Wilderness 5 May, 1864. Admitted to 2nd Div. 5th Corps Hospital where the leg was amputated at the hip. Transferred 7 May, 1864 to Cotton Factory Hospital at Fredericksburg where he died of his wounds 18 May, 1864. Son of **Richard and Orpha** (NARA). Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).
