

The National Organization of Professional Black Natural Resources Conservation Service Employees (NOPBNRCSE) is also known as The Organization. The Organization Scholarship Program is committed to providing ten (10) \$1,000.00 scholarships to deserving students pursuing a bachelor's degree in the Agricultural Sciences or related fields. Applicants must be currently enrolled, or planning to attend one of the following 1890 universities:

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of the Organization Scholarship Program is:

- * To strengthen the long-term partnership between the Organization, USDA, and the 1890 institutions.
- * To increase the number of students studying agriculture, natural resource sciences and other related disciplines.

Objective

The Organization offers a one-time limited scholarship fund to U.S. citizens who are seeking a bachelor's degree at one of the eighteen 1890 Historically Black Land-Grant Institutions. The field of study must be in the area of agriculture, natural resource sciences, or related disciplines. Studies must be in the following:

- Agriculture Agriculture Business/Management Agriculture Economics Agriculture Engineering/Mechanics Agriculture Production and Technology Agronomy or Crop Science Animal Science
- Botany Farm and Range Management Forestry Horticulture Natural Resource Management Soil Conservation/Soil Science Wildlife Management

The Award

Ten scholarships of \$1000.00 each are awarded annually, which must be used at one of the listed 1890 Historically Black Land-Grant Institutions.

Who May Apply

Applicants who are U.S. citizens that have a high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate, and are starting or already enrolled in one of the listed colleges or universities for the fall semester. The minimum grade point average is 2.8 for consideration.

General Eligibility

The Applicant Must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be an entering freshman, or already enrolled at a college or university as of the fall semester/quarter for the 2006-2007 school year.
- Hold a High School Diploma or G.E.D. certificate
- Have a High School/College GPA of 2.8 or better
- Attend one of the eighteen 1890 Historically Black Land-Grant Institutions listed
- Study Agriculture, Natural Resource Sciences, or other related fields
- Submit the completed Application Form
- Submit a copy of an official or certified high school or college transcript
- Submit two (2) letters of recommendation
 - one from a Teacher, Professor, Counselor, etc., and
 - one from a community leader
- Sign application where applicable (original signature only)
