- To determine if the certificate holder follows its procedures, controls, process measurements, and interfaces for the RII Training Requirements process.
- To determine if there were any changes in the personnel identified by the certificate holder as having responsibility and/or authority for the RII Training Requirements process.

### **Specific Instructions:**

 To accomplish this EPI, the inspector will review the certificate holder's RII list and procedures as defined by their manual, and ensure that the RII Training syllabus/curriculum covers each item.
