ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1897-A

On September 25, 2003, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to NUI Energy Brokers, Inc. (NUIEB) in DOE/FE Order No. 1897 (Order 1897)^{1/2} to import and export up to a combined total of 250 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico over a two-year term beginning on October 1, 2003, and extending through September 30, 2005.

On March 12, 2004, NUIEB filed a letter requesting that FE vacate Order 1897. NUIEB no longer engages in any import or export activities, and has no such transactions currently in effect.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, DOE/FE Order No. 1897, authorizing the import and export of natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico, is hereby vacated.
