Note: This exception does not apply if the contract carrier(s) offers a comparable fare and has seats available at the fare or if the lower fare offered by a noncontract carrier is restricted to government and military travelers on official business and may only be purchased with a GTR or Government Diners Club card, E.G., YDG, MDG, ODG, VDG, and similar fares.
