He then lists the qualities a candidate should possess, and endorses Richard M. Nixon, and Henry Cabot Lodge as having these qualities. He describes the duties of the President of the United States as Chief of State, Commander in Chief of the Armed Forces, head of the National Security, and guardian of free enterprise. He stresses the importance of foreign relations, and lists the accomplishments of his administration in this field, such as Korea, Viet Nam; Formosa; the Philippines; the Suez Canal; Trieste; Iran. Eisenhower emphasizes Nixon's and Lodge's experience in foreign affairs, and stresses that caution and deliberation are needed in international situations.
