The Committee on the Judiciary had referred to it 1,070 bills and resolutions during the 101st Congress. This represents 18% of the 5,977 bills and resolutions introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives for that Congress. Of this number, 901 were public bills and resolutions, and 169 were private bills and resolutions. A total of 58 which received consideration by the Committee were enacted into public law; and a total of 13 measures considered by the Committee were enacted into private law.
