Delaware, Lackawanna and Western Railroad, Postal Storage Car #2054. C2054, 81557

Postal Storage Car, #2054. Class: BX then MR. Builder: Pressed Steel Car Company, 1925. Series: 2000-2109 then Series 2035-2064. An all steel car, originally carried express shipments on passenger trains. Later assigned as a postal storage car carrying bulk mail. In 1965 the Erie Lackawanna repainted and renumbered the car to #457. About 1969-1970 reduced to maintenance of way service and renumbered to #489011; same number used by Conrail after the 1976 take over. Steamtown Foundation purchased car from Conrail in 1987.
