AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 9, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTIONS 16-586 AND 16-587; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; RELATING TO POLLING PLACE PROCEDURES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 9, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding sections 16-586 and 16-587, to read:

4 16-586. Definition of identification

5 A. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, "IDENTIFICATION" MEANS ALL OF THE  
6 FOLLOWING:

7 1. ANY ITEM THAT IS DELIVERED THROUGH THE UNITED STATES MAIL WITH A  
8 POSTMARK OR CANCELLATION AND THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON.

9 2. ANY BILL OR STATEMENT THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE  
10 PERSON.

11 3. A PAYCHECK OR PAY STUB THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE  
12 PERSON.

13 4. A GOVERNMENT ISSUED CHECK OR OTHER GOVERNMENT DOCUMENT THAT SHOWS  
14 THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON AND THAT IS ISSUED BY ANY BRANCH,  
15 DEPARTMENT, AGENCY OR ENTITY OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT OR OF THIS STATE  
16 OR BY ANY COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, BOARD, AUTHORITY OR OTHER POLITICAL  
17 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.

18 5. AN EMPLOYEE IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND ADDRESS  
19 OF THE PERSON AND THAT IS ISSUED BY A PRIVATE EMPLOYER OR BY ANY BRANCH,  
20 DEPARTMENT, AGENCY OR ENTITY OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT OR OF THIS STATE  
21 OR BY ANY COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, BOARD, AUTHORITY OR OTHER POLITICAL  
22 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.

23 6. A TRIBAL DOCUMENT THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON AND  
24 THAT IS ISSUED BY A FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBE.

25 7. A VALID UNITED STATES MILITARY IDENTIFICATION CARD.

26 8. A VALID UNITED STATES PASSPORT.

27 B. THE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A ARE VALID  
28 WITHOUT REGARD TO WHETHER THE ADDRESS SHOWN FOR THE PERSON IS A MAILING  
29 ADDRESS, A RESIDENTIAL STREET ADDRESS, A LOCATION DESCRIPTION OR A POST  
30 OFFICE BOX.

31 16-587. Insufficient identification; appeal; challenge;  
32 provisional ballot

33 IF THE ELECTION OFFICER DETERMINES THAT THE IDENTIFICATION PRESENTED BY  
34 THE ELECTOR TO OBTAIN A BALLOT IS INSUFFICIENT, THE ELECTION OFFICER SHALL  
35 INFORM THE ELECTOR THAT THE ELECTOR IS ENTITLED TO APPEAL THAT DETERMINATION  
36 AND THE MATTER SHALL BE DETERMINED AS A CHALLENGE OF THE VOTER PURSUANT TO  
37 SECTIONS 16-591 AND 16-592. IF THE ELECTION BOARD DETERMINES THAT THE  
38 CHALLENGE IS VALID, THE ELECTION BOARD SHALL INFORM THE ELECTOR THAT THE  
39 ELECTOR IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE A PROVISIONAL BALLOT PURSUANT TO SECTION 16-584  
40 AND THE ELECTOR SHALL BE PERMITTED TO VOTE A PROVISIONAL BALLOT.

1           Sec. 2. Appropriation: county elections programs

2           The sum of up to \$1,400,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2007-2008  
3 from the election systems improvement fund established by section 41-129,  
4 Arizona Revised Statutes, to the secretary of state to be disbursed to the  
5 offices of the county recorders for purposes of performing training and  
6 developing procedures for implementing this act. Each county recorder shall  
7 submit a claim to the secretary of state for the costs of implementation and  
8 the secretary of state shall make payments to county recorders from the  
9 monies appropriated pursuant to this section.
