

CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE COST ESTIMATE

H.R. 2061

An act to amend the charter of Southeastern University of the District of Columbia

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Governmental Affairs on November 14, 2001

H.R. 2061 would amend the charter of Southeastern University, eliminating the requirement that at least one-third of the board of trustees be graduates of the university. CBO estimates that enacting H.R. 2061 would have no significant impact on the federal budget. The act would not affect direct spending or receipts, so pay-as-you-go procedures would not apply. H.R. 2061 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.

On August 1, 2001, CBO prepared a cost estimate for H.R. 2061 as ordered reported by the House Committee on Government Reform on July 25, 2001. The two versions of the legislation are identical, as are the cost estimates.
