AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 42-13007, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO LOCALLY ASSESSED PROPERTY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 42-13007, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 42-13007. Education, training and certification advisory
5 committee

6 A. The education, training and certification advisory committee is
7 established consisting of the following members:

8 1. A member of the state board of equalization who is appointed by the
9 chairman of the state board.

10 2. Three county assessors or deputy county assessors who are appointed
11 by the director.

12 3. A training coordinator in the property ~~valuation and equalization~~
13 ~~TAX~~ division of the department who is appointed by the director.

14 B. The members who are appointed pursuant to subsection A, paragraphs
15 1 and 2 shall be appointed to one year terms. The training coordinator who
16 serves pursuant to subsection A, paragraph 3 serves at the pleasure of the
17 director, shall serve as secretary to the committee and shall keep written
18 minutes of all committee meetings. The members of the committee shall choose
19 a chairman from among the members. The committee shall meet at least
20 semiannually at a time and place set by the chairman. Additional meetings
21 shall be held on the call of the chairman or at the request of two or more
22 members.

23 C. The committee shall evaluate:

24 1. The guidelines proposed by the department for placing persons who
25 apply for admission to the assessor certification program into the proper
26 professional level of certification.

27 2. The guidelines proposed by the department pertaining to appraisal
28 reports, experience, education or training submitted for credit in the
29 assessor certification program.

30 3. The curriculum proposed by the department for the assessor
31 certification program.

32 4. The procedures proposed by the department for grading demonstration
33 appraisal reports, including any graders who are designated for the reports.
