Dear Mr. Danis:

The above-captioned case, petitioning for an investigation and determination of representative under Section 9(c) of the National Labor Relations Act, has been investigated and considered.

Since United Electrical, Radio, and Machine Workers of America, and its affiliate, Local 221, has disclaimed any interest in representing the employees involved in this proceeding, the petition that you filed should be, and hereby is, dismissed.

Moreover, in view of such disclaimer, United Electrical, Radio, and Machine Workers of America, and its affiliate, Local 221, is no longer the exclusive representative of the employees in the unit involved in this proceeding.

Any petition filed by United Electrical, Radio, and Machine Workers of America, and its affiliate, Local 221 within 6 months from this date will not be entertained unless good cause is shown to the contrary. Moreover in the event the union makes a claim for recognition upon this employer within 6 months from this date involving the same or substantially the same unit, a motion by the petitioner herein requesting reinstatement of this petition will be entertained. *Little Road Machinery Co.*, 107 NLRB 715 (1954).

Rules and Regulations permit you to obtain a review of this action by filing a request for review with the National Labor Relations Board. If you wish to file a request for review, your attention is directed to the following, which summarizes the provisions of Section 102.71(c) of the Rules:

Request Due Date: The request for review <u>must be received by the Executive Secretary of the Board in Washington, D.C.</u> by the close of business at 5 p.m. on June 5, 2007. However, if you mail the request, it will be considered timely if it is postmarked no later than one day before the due date. <u>The request MAY NOT be filed by facsimile</u>

<u>transmission.</u> You may file the request for review electronically. Further guidance may be found under E-Gov on the National Labor Relations Board web site: www.nlrb.gov.

Extension of Time to File Request: If you provide a good reason, the National Labor Relations Board may grant you an extension of time to file the request for review. You may file a request for an extension of time by mail, by facsimile transmission, or through the Internet. The fax number is (202) 273-4270. Special instructions for requesting an extension of time over the Internet are set forth in the attached Access Code Certificate. Any request for an extension of time must be received by the due date indicated above. A copy of any request for extension of time should be sent to me.

Request Contents: The request for review (eight copies) must contain a complete statement setting forth the facts and the reasons why you believe the decision to dismiss the petition is incorrect.

Address for Request for Review: The request should be sent to the Executive Secretary of the National Labor Relations Board, 1099 14th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20570 by the due date specified above. You should send a copy of the request to me, and one copy of the request to each of the parties whose names and addresses are listed below.
