AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 16-646, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ELECTIONS AND ELECTORS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 16-646, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:
4 16-646. Statement, contents and mailing of official canvass
5 A. When the result of the canvass is determined, a statement, known
6 and designated as the official canvass, shall be entered on the official
7 record of the election district which shall show:
8 1. The number of ballots cast in each precinct and in the county.
9 2. The number of ballots rejected in each precinct and in the county.
10 3. The titles of the offices voted for and the names of the persons,
11 together with the party designation, if any, of each person voted for to fill
12 the offices.
13 4. The number of votes by precincts and county received by each
14 candidate.
15 5. The numbers and a brief title of each proposed constitutional
16 amendment and each initiated or referred measure voted upon.
17 6. The number of votes by precincts and county for and against such
18 proposed amendment or measure.
19 B. The certified permanent copy of the official canvass for all
20 offices and ballot measures, except offices and ballot measures in a city or
21 town election and nonpartisan election returns, shall be mailed immediately
22 to the secretary of state who shall maintain and preserve ~~them~~ **IT** as a
23 permanent public record.
24 C. The board of supervisors shall deliver a copy of the official
25 canvass for all offices and ballot measures in the primary and general
26 elections to the secretary of state in a uniform electronic computer media
27 format that shall be agreed upon between the secretary of state and all
28 county election officials. The uniform format shall be designed to
29 facilitate the computer analysis of election results for offices and ballot
30 measures that are statewide or are common to more than one county.
31 D. The certified permanent copy of the official canvass for all
32 offices and ballot measures in a city or town election shall be filed with
33 the appropriate city or town clerk, or in a special district election with
34 the clerk of the board of supervisors, who shall maintain and preserve ~~them~~
35 **IT** as a permanent public record.
