Classification and Correlation
of the Soils of
Grant County, Indiana

This amendment results from a memorandum from Robert L. Eddleman to Maurice Stout, Jr. dated February 14, 1985 and a telephone conversation between Jerry D. Larson and Robert I. Turner for clarification on March 11, 1985. The resulting decisions are outlined below.

Page 3 -- Field Symbols Approved map unit name
 Add: Pw to Pewamo silty clay loam

Page 6 -- Disposition of Original Atlas Field Sheets:
 Change the date of January 1985 to September 1985

Page 8 -- Remove GsB3 Glynwood silty clay, 2 to 6 percent slopes,
 severely eroded, from the list of PRIME FARMLAND.

Page 9 -- Field symbol Publication symbol
 Add: Pw Add: Pw (in alphabetical order)

Page 10 -- Publication symbol
 Change GrB3 to GrB2
