ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2115-A

On July 29, 2005, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Eagle Energy Marketing Canada, L.P. (EEMC) in DOE/FE Order No. 2115 (Order 2115) to import up to 70.6 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada and to export up to 70.6 Bcf of natural gas to Canada over a two-year term beginning on May 1, 2005, and extending through April 30, 2007.¹

On December 29, 2005, EEMC notified DOE that it had ceased importing and exporting natural gas on November 30, 2005, and no longer needs its current authorization.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 2115, authorizing the import and export of natural gas from and to Canada, is hereby vacated.
