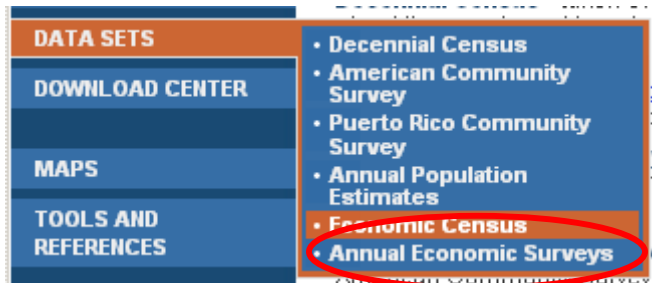

For total number of employer establishments:

1. Go to factfinder.census.gov
2. Choose “Annual Economic Surveys” from the “Data Sets” menu



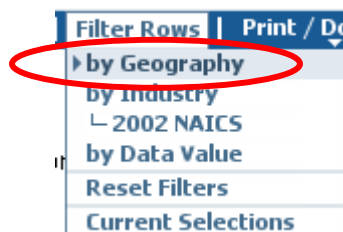
3. Choose “Business Patterns”



4. Choose the data set “CBP: GAS: County Business Patterns: 2005”



5. From the “Filter Rows” menu, select “by Geography”



6. From the drop-down menu, select “State”
7. From the next menu, select “Alabama”
8. Click “Add”

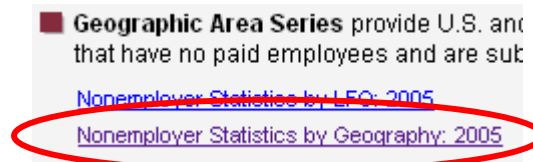
For total number of nonemployer establishments:

11. Return to the Annual Economic Surveys Web page by clicking “Main”, then choose “Annual Economic Surveys” from the “Data Sets” menu.

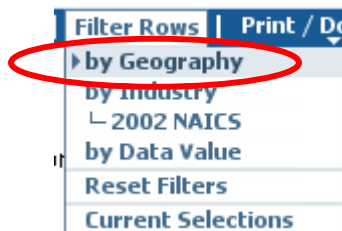
12. Choose “Nonemployer Statistics”

### For total number of establishments:

20. The total number of establishments in Alabama in 2005 equals the total employer establishments plus the total nonemployer establishments

a. 101,976 employers + 282,604 nonemployers = **384,580 establishments**
