AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 32, CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 32-1910; RELATING TO THE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 32, chapter 18, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 32-1910, to read:

4 32-1910. Emergencies; continued provision of services

5 A. IF AN EMERGENCY HAS BEEN DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR OR BY A COUNTY,
6 CITY OR TOWN PURSUANT TO ITS AUTHORITY, THE BOARD SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE
7 STATE AND THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO ENSURE THE PROVISION OF DRUGS, DEVICES
8 AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC.

9 B. THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT RULES FOR THE PROVISION OF PHARMACEUTICAL
10 CARE AND DRUG AND DEVICE DELIVERY DURING A DECLARED EMERGENCY, INCLUDING THE
11 USE OF TEMPORARY OR MOBILE PHARMACY FACILITIES AND NONRESIDENT LICENSED
12 PHARMACY PROFESSIONALS.
