On February 17, 2006, we issued an Environmental Assessment for the Markham Ferry Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2183). On the same date, by letter, we informed the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service of our determination that one of your agency's recommended fish and wildlife measures, made pursuant to section 10(j) of the Federal Power Act (FPA), may be inconsistent with the substantial evidence standard of sections 313(b) of the FPA.

I believe that a teleconference may help to resolve the remaining issue associated with the Markham Ferry Project relicensing. Consequently, we will hold a section 10(j) teleconference on April 20, 2006. The teleconference is scheduled from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. EST.
