## **DECISION AND ORDER**

This proceeding is before the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission pursuant to section 10 of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, 29 U.S.C. sec 651 et seq.

Following an inspection of a work site of the Respondent in Staten Island, N.Y., the Occupational Safety and Health Administration issued a serious citation. Respondent timely contested the citation and proposed penalty, and on May 2, 2001, this case came on to be heard in New York, N.Y.
