Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
Section 1. Appropriation: health care institutions: cancer
research and treatment; exemption

- A. The sum of \$15,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 2009-2010 to the department of health services for distribution to health care institutions in Maricopa and Pima counties that are designated by the National Cancer Institute to perform research, treatment, education and preventive research into cancers that are unique to women. The department shall distribute these monies as follows:
 - 1. The sum of \$10,000,000 for institutions in Maricopa county.
 - 2. The sum of \$5,000,000 for institutions in Pima county.
- B. The amount distributed to each institution by the department shall equal one-third of monies raised by the institution within an eighteen month period ending June 30, 2009. If in either county a full state match would exceed the amount appropriated pursuant to subsection A of this section, the department shall reduce proportionately the distribution to each qualifying institution.
- C. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations until January 1, 2011.
