HOUSE BILL 2230

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK UTILITY SERVICES LEGISLATIVE STUDY
COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Recreational vehicle park utility services
3 legislative study committee; membership; purpose;
4 report

5 A. The recreational vehicle park utility services legislative study
6 committee is established consisting of the following members:

7 1. Two members of the house of representatives who are appointed by
8 the speaker of the house of representatives and who are representatives of
9 two different political parties. The speaker of the house of representatives
10 shall designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson of the study
11 committee.

12 2. Two members of the senate who are appointed by the president of the
13 senate and who are representatives of two different political parties. The
14 president of the senate shall designate one of these members to serve as
15 cochairperson of the study committee.

16 3. The chairman of the Arizona corporation commission or the
17 chairman's designee.

18 4. One representative of the residential consumer utility office who
19 is appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

20 5. One representative of a recreational vehicle park association who
21 is appointed by the president of the senate.

22 6. One representative of a manufactured homeowners' association who is
23 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

24 7. One representative of a manufactured home park association who is
25 appointed by the president of the senate.

26 B. The study committee shall:

27 1. Identify utility rates being charged to recreational vehicle parks
28 by Arizona utility companies.

29 2. Identify utility rates being charged to long-term recreational
30 vehicle tenants in Arizona recreational vehicle parks and manufactured home
31 parks.

32 3. Identify an appropriate method for cost allocation of those
33 utilities to the tenants in those parks.

34 4. Recommend recreational vehicle park utility services legislation
35 that incorporates the findings of the committee.

36 C. The recreational vehicle park utility services legislative study
37 committee shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the
38 speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the senate on or
39 before December 31, 2007. The committee shall provide a copy of the report
40 to the secretary of state and the director of the Arizona state library,
41 archives and public records.

42 Sec. 2. Delayed repeal

43 This act is repealed from and after May 31, 2008.
