## U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE AIRBOAT OPERATION DOCUMENTATION FORM

The Watercraft Safety Chapter of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Manual, 241 FW 1, requires that airboat operators must complete the Department of the Interior Motorboat Operator Certification Course, complete the airboat training module, and have 40 hours of documented driving time, before qualifying to operate airboats independently.

Service employees or volunteers who can document 40 or more hours of airboat driving prior to joining the Service are deemed to have met the 40-hour requirement.

Service employees or volunteers with no prior airboat driving time may obtain the 40 hours of driving time either before or after completion of the airboat training module, but, in either case, it must be under the direct supervision of a qualified Service airboat operator.
