# HOUSE BILL 2240

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 35, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 35-194; RELATING TO BUDGET UNIT FEES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 35, chapter 1, article 5, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 35-194, to read:

4 35-194. Budget unit fees; limitation; adjustment

5 BY DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH BUDGET UNIT THAT HAS AN OPERATING  
6 BUDGET CONSISTING OF ANY REVENUE RECEIVED FROM FEES SHALL REVISE ITS FEE  
7 ASSESSMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

8 1. FOR APPROPRIATED FUNDS, IF THE REVENUE COLLECTED FROM FEE  
9 ASSESSMENTS DURING THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR IS MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TEN PER  
10 CENT OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR'S APPROPRIATION OF FEE REVENUES, THE DIRECTOR  
11 SHALL REVISE ALL FEES ON A UNIFORM PERCENTAGE BASIS. THE DIRECTOR SHALL  
12 REVISE THE FEES IN SUCH A MANNER THAT THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE FEES  
13 DURING THE SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR EQUALS NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TEN PER  
14 CENT OF THE APPROPRIATED BUDGET FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR.

15 2. FOR NONAPPROPRIATED FUNDS, IF THE REVENUE COLLECTED FROM FEE  
16 ASSESSMENTS DURING THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR IS MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TEN PER  
17 CENT OF THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR'S EXPENDITURE OF FEE REVENUES, THE DIRECTOR  
18 SHALL REVISE ALL FEES ON A UNIFORM PERCENTAGE BASIS. THE DIRECTOR SHALL  
19 REVISE THE FEES IN SUCH A MANNER THAT THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE FEES  
20 DURING THE SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR EQUALS NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TEN PER  
21 CENT OF THE NONAPPROPRIATED FEE EXPENDITURES FOR THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR.
