AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 25, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING
SECTION 25-515; RELATING TO FAMILY SUPPORT DUTIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 25, chapter 5, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 25-515, to read:

4 25-515. Title IV-D recipients; fee

5 A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CHARGE AND WITHHOLD AN ANNUAL FEE OF
6 TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FROM EACH RECIPIENT OF TITLE IV-D SERVICES WHO HAS NEVER
7 RECEIVED PUBLIC ASSISTANCE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WITHHOLD THIS FEE FROM THE
8 FIRST PAYMENT TO THE RECIPIENT OF SUPPORT THAT EXCEEDS FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS
9 EACH YEAR.

10 B. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ITS PORTION
11 OF EACH FEE WITHHELD PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL
12 DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND 35-147, THE REMAINDER IN A CHILD
13 SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION FUND.

14 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; two-thirds vote

15 Pursuant to article IX, section 22, Constitution of Arizona, this act
16 is effective only on the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the
17 members of each house of the legislature and is effective immediately on the
18 signature of the governor or, if the governor vetoes this act, on the
19 subsequent affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of each
20 house of the legislature.
