Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject product, Desmodur R-E, is a crosslinker for solvent borne polyurethane and polychloroprene adhesives. The proponent claims that the product imparts rapid curing properties and heat resistance to materials such as PVC, rubber, and leather for use in shoe soles.

Bayer MaterialScience imports this product from its affiliated company in Germany. There are no other known importers of this product. However, competitive products are imported from Asia and Europe.
