AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 49-425, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO AIR QUALITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 49-425, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 49-425. Rules; hearing

5 A. The director shall adopt ~~such~~ rules ~~as he~~ THE DIRECTOR determines
6 are necessary and feasible to reduce the release into the atmosphere of air
7 contaminants originating within the territorial limits of ~~the~~ THIS state or
8 any portion ~~thereof~~ OF THIS STATE and shall adopt, modify, ~~and~~ amend
9 reasonable standards for the quality of, and emissions into, the ambient air
10 of ~~the~~ THIS state for the prevention, control and abatement of air pollution.
11 Additional standards shall be established for particulate matter emissions,
12 sulfur dioxide emissions, ~~and~~ other air contaminant emissions determined to
13 be necessary and feasible for the prevention, control and abatement of air
14 pollution. In fixing ~~such~~ THE ambient air quality standards, emission
15 standards or standards of performance, the director shall give consideration
16 but shall not be limited to the relevant factors prescribed by the clean air
17 act.

18 B. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ADOPT BY RULE THE FOLLOWING:

19 1. THE CALIFORNIA MOTOR VEHICLE EMISSION STANDARDS IN TITLE 13 OF THE
20 CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED
21 IN THIS SUBSECTION TO IMPLEMENT THE CLEAN CAR EMISSION STANDARDS OF THE STATE
22 OF CALIFORNIA FOR PASSENGER CARS, LIGHT DUTY TRUCKS AND MEDIUM DUTY PASSENGER
23 VEHICLES. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT THE ZERO EMISSION VEHICLE PROGRAM
24 REGULATIONS CONTAINED IN THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS ONLY IN AREA A OR
25 B AS NECESSARY TO MEET APPLICABLE AIR QUALITY STANDARDS. THE RULES SHALL
26 APPLY TO NEW VEHICLES SOLD IN THIS STATE BEGINNING IN 2008.

27 2. STANDARDS FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, COMMERCIAL FLEETS AND GOVERNMENT
28 FLEETS THAT ARE DESIGNED FOR A REDUCTION IN VEHICLE IDLING TIME OF EIGHTY PER
29 CENT BY 2010 AND ONE HUNDRED PER CENT BY 2015.

30 ~~B.~~ C. No rule may be ~~enacted~~ ADOPTED or amended except after the
31 director first holds a public hearing after twenty days' notice of such
32 hearing. The proposed rule, or any proposed amendment of a rule, shall be
33 made available to the public at the time of notice of such hearing.

34 ~~C.~~ D. The department shall enforce the rules adopted by the director.

35 ~~D.~~ E. All rules ~~enacted~~ ADOPTED pursuant to this section shall be
36 made available to the public at a reasonable charge ~~upon~~ ON request.
