By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. Colorado Springs School District 11 (Colorado Springs SD 11), Colorado Springs, Colorado, seeks review of an April 22, 2003 decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator).<sup>1</sup> For a review of decisions by SLD issued on or after August 13, 2001, appeals to the Commission must be filed within 60 days of the issuance of the SLD decision date.<sup>2</sup> Here, Colorado Springs SD 11 filed its appeal on June 25, 2003, after the 60-day period, in contravention of our rules. We therefore dismiss the appeal.
