By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. New Haven Public Schools (New Haven), New Haven, Connecticut, seeks review of a December 20, 2002 decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator). For a review of decisions by SLD issued on or after August 13, 2001, appeals to the Commission must be filed within 60 days of the issuance of the SLD decision date. Here, New Haven filed its appeal on February 20, 2003, after the 60-day period, in contravention of our rules. We therefore dismiss the appeal.
