SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) Square (40' x 40') plus ell; 2 stories plus mansard story; 3-bay front; mansard roof.		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Orth front: 1-story, 3-bay entrance porch with bracketed balustrade; bracketed oriel on 2nd floor; cross mansard. South side: bracketed bay window. In general: wide, bracketed eaves; elaborate cast-iron fence.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Center hall plan; stairway with 8-sided newel; plaster cornices and ceiling medallions; marble fireplaces.
