By the Chief, Video Division:

1. At the request of Liberty County Educational Foundation ("petitioner"), the Commission has before it the <u>Notice of Proposed Rule Making</u>, 19 FCC Rcd 2671 (2004), proposing the allotment of DTV channel 3 to Apalachicola, Florida, as the community's first local commercial television service. Petitioner filed comments restating its intention to apply for DTV channel 3, if allotted. No other comments were received.

2. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting DTV channel 3 to Apalachicola since it would provide the community with its first local television service. DTV channel 3 can be allotted to Apalachicola, Florida, as proposed, in compliance Sections 73.623(d) and 73.625(a) of the Commission's rules at coordinates 29-45-05 N. and 84-52-19 W. with the following specifications:
