## AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS OF BORDER COUNTIES FOR COUNTY COSTS RELATED TO ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Appropriations: border county costs: exemption

- A. The sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ is appropriated from the state general fund in each of the fiscal years 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 to the boards of supervisors of the border counties in amounts determined pursuant to subsection B of this section to partially reimburse the disproportionate costs to the criminal justice system, medical examiner, indigent burial services, environmental remediation and emergency medical services associated with the illegal immigrant population.
- B. Fifty per cent of the monies appropriated in subsection A of this section in each fiscal year shall be distributed to Pima county and the remainder of the monies shall be distributed equally among Cochise county, Santa Cruz county and Yuma county.
- C. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are exempt from the provisions of section 35–190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations.
