AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 49-333, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE WATER
QUALITY CONTROL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 49-333, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 49-333. Regulation of dry wells; license to drill

5 A. The director may adopt rules establishing standards for new and
6 existing dry wells pertaining to their performance, operation, construction,
7 design, closure, location and inspection.

8 B. Dry wells shall not be used for the disposal of hazardous
9 substances as defined in the comprehensive environmental response,
10 compensation, and liability act (P.L. 96-510), as amended, or oil as defined
11 in the federal water pollution control act (P.L. 92-500), as amended.

12 C. New dry well construction, including modifications of existing dry
13 wells, shall be performed under the direct and personal supervision of a well
14 driller who holds a dry well driller's license issued under this section. A
15 person who intends to construct or modify one or more dry wells in this state
16 shall file an application for a dry well driller's license with the
17 director. The application shall include:

18 1. The name, mailing address and place of business of the applicant.

19 2. The applicant's experience and qualifications.

20 3. Such other information as the director may require.

21 D. The director shall, by rule, establish qualifications and a
22 reasonable fee of not more than fifty dollars for licenses for dry well
23 drillers and establish procedures for the evaluation and licensing of
24 applicants. The rules shall establish qualifications for the protection of
25 the public and shall include knowledge in the areas of location, design,
26 construction, operation, maintenance and closure of dry wells. A
27 nontransferable dry well driller's license shall be issued if the director
28 finds that the applicant meets the qualifications established by the
29 director. The director may revoke a DRY well driller's license for good
30 cause.
