REPEALING SECTION 41-3006.23, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3016.01; RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section 41-3006.23, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3016.01, to read:

6 41-3016.01. Department of economic security; termination July
7 1, 2016

8 A. THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2016.

9 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 14 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2017.

10 Sec. 3. Purpose

11 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 the legislature continues the department of economic security to provide
13 social services, welfare programs, vocational rehabilitation and employment
14 services and mental retardation and other developmental disability programs.

15 Sec. 4. Department of economic security; auditor general
16 recommendations; progress report

17 On or before December 1, 2007 and December 1, 2008, the department of
18 economic security shall orally report to the senate family services committee
19 of reference subcommittee and the house of representatives human services
20 committee of reference subcommittee. The report shall describe the
21 department's progress and implementation of the auditor general
22 recommendations that are contained in the following auditor general reports:

23 1. Department of Economic Security–Sunset Factors (September 2005,
24 Report No. 05-08).

25 2. Department of Economic Security–Division of Developmental
26 Disabilities (September 2005, Report No. 05-07).

27 3. Department of Economic Security–Service Integration Initiative
28 (July 2005, Report No. 05-05).

29 4. Department of Economic Security–Information Security (July 2005,
30 Report No. 05-04).

31 5. Department of Economic Security–Division of Children, Youth and
32 Families–Child Protective Services–CHILDS Data Integrity Process (May 2005,
33 Report No. CPS-0501).

34 6. Department of Economic Security–Division of Employment and
35 Rehabilitation Services–Unemployment Insurance Program (January 2005, Report
36 No. 05-01).

37 7. Department of Economic Security–Welfare Programs (April 2004,
38 Report No. 04-02).

39 Sec. 5. Retroactivity

40 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
41 2006.
