Jim,

Thank you for addressing my comments in the call yesterday. I'd like to offer the following response on how the group decided to address my general comment regarding the rationale for the numeric goals set in the paper. My understanding of the approach to be taken is that a paragraph describing what each work group did to come up with the goal would be added to the document. I think it would be far better and much more useful if the INC provided a more detailed presentation of how the goals were derived. This could be done in an appendix to facilitate incorporating it into the document.

I make this suggestion because the work has already been done by the various work groups within INC and the readers of this document would benefit from a more detailed write up of the calculations used as well as the logic behind the use of existing data sources. I also repeat the statement made in my original comments: In the inevitable debate which would accompany efforts to achieve the stated INC decreased Nr goals, a clear presentation of the process which led to selecting those goals would help avoid numerous debates about that process.
