Built by Sam & Joe Musser, located on the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, T. 105 Range 10, Saratoga Township.

Bought in 1898 by Frank Slaven, present owner; address St. Charles, Minn.

At unknown date the rear stone wall was removed or fell, and a timber addition was built. The water power was replaced by a small steam plant. Not in use for some years. Most of the machinery and grinding stones (for grain) are still in place.
