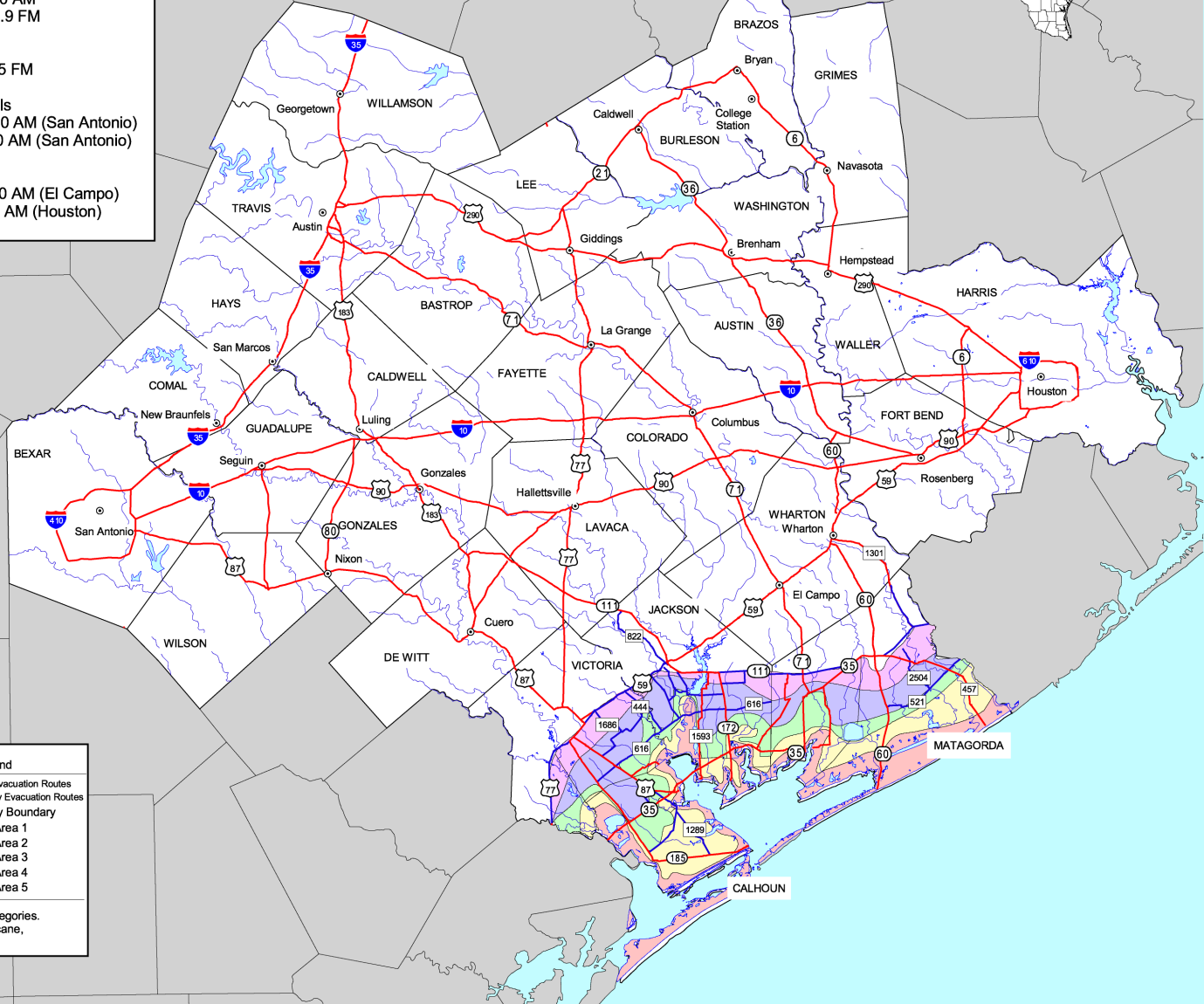
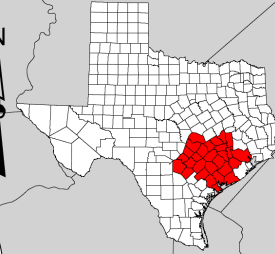


# Inland Evacuation Map Matagorda Study Area
