Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: Section 1. Section 12-712, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

12-712. <u>Nonliability for damages that result during a criminal</u> act

- A. In any civil action, THE FINDER OF FACT MAY FIND a defendant is not liable for damages that the plaintiff incurs if the plaintiff is harmed as a result of the negligence or gross negligence of any defendant while the plaintiff is attempting to commit, committing or fleeing from a felony criminal act.
- B. In a— ANY civil action, THE FINDER OF FACT MAY FIND a defendant is not liable for damages that the plaintiff incurs if the plaintiff is harmed as a result of the negligence or gross negligence of the defendant while the plaintiff is attempting to commit or committing a misdemeanor criminal act and the act directly relates to the defendant or the defendant's property.
