Administration evaluation of the examination the on 17 Constitutions of the United States and Arizona, not less than six dollars and 18 not more than twelve dollars for regularly scheduled administrations and not 19 less than twelve dollars and not more than twenty dollars for administrations 20 other than regularly scheduled administrations. 21 4. Administration and evaluation of the reading, grammar and 22 mathematics proficiency examination for applicants for teaching certificates, 23 not less than ten dollars and not more than twenty dollars. 24 Sec. 2. Section 15-533, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 25 15-533. Proficiency examination A. To qualify for either a basic or standard teaching certificate, or 26 27 equivalent certificate later adopted by the state board of education, a 28 person must pass each component of the proficiency examination developed and 29 administered by the state board of education. The proficiency examination 30 shall consist of only a professional knowledge test, A PERFORMANCE TEST and a 31 subject knowledge test. A person is not required to take a component of the 32 examination if the person has passed a component on a proficiency examination 33 which THAT has been adopted by a state board of education or equivalent 34 agency in another state and which THAT has been determined to be equivalent 35 to the applicable component on the examination prescribed in this section by 36 the state board of education in this state. The state board of education may 37 grant a basic or standard teaching certificate for not to exceed one year to 38 a teacher who is a nonresident and who has not met the requirement of this 39 section at the time of application. 40 B. A person is not required to pass the proficiency examination or the 41 equivalent examination more than once, except that a person who passed the 42 examination seven or more years before qualifying to teach in this state is 43 required to repass the examination.
