

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2418, AS REPORTED**

**OFFERED BY MR. BARRETT OF WISCONSIN**

Page 28, after line 3, insert the following subsection  
(and redesignate subsequent subsections accordingly):

1           “(c) GRANTS TO STATES.—The Secretary may make  
2 grants to States for the purpose of assisting States in car-  
3 rying out organ donor awareness, public education and  
4 outreach activities and programs designed to increase the  
5 number of organ donors within the State, including living  
6 donors. To be eligible, each State shall—

7           “(1) submit an application to the Department  
8 in the form prescribed;

9           “(2) establish yearly benchmarks for improve-  
10 ment in organ donation rates in the State;

11           “(3) develop, enhance or expand a State donor  
12 registry, which shall be available to hospitals, organ  
13 procurement organizations, and other States upon a  
14 search request; and

15           “(4) report to the Secretary on an annual basis  
16 a description and assessment of the State’s use of  
17 these grant funds, accompanied by an assessment of  
18 initiatives for potential replication in other States.

19 Funds may be used by the State or in partnership with  
20 other public agencies or private sector institutions for edu-

1 cation and awareness efforts, information dissemination,  
2 activities pertaining to the State organ donor registry, and  
3 other innovative donation specific initiatives, including liv-  
4 ing donation.

Page 28, line 12, strike “\$10,000,000” and insert  
“\$15,000,000”.
